Beth Gerwe is the North Texas Inclusion Leader for Deloitte and a leader within Deloitte Tax LLP, focusing on strategy and transformation. She has been with Deloitte for 20 years, focusing most of her career within Deloitte Consulting LLP. serving clients in various industries with strategic transformation, merger and acquisition integration, technology implementation, and human resources transformation. Gerwe also has performed strategic change management services for Deloitte through several acquisitions, organizational reorganizations, system implementations and strategic transformations.

Prior to joining Deloitte, Gerwe served as the leader for Texas Instruments' Defense Systems Organizational Development group and began her career as an industrial engineer with General Motors. She holds a bachelor's degree in industrial engineering from the University of Oklahoma, master's degree in organizational behavior from the University of Texas at Dallas and is certified as a senior professional in human resources. She is a member of the Board of Trustees at Parish Episcopal School and leads the Advancement Committee for the school. Additionally, she is a member of the Board of Directors for Dallas Dinner Table, an organization focused on achieving an America without racism, one meal at a time.

Abstract
